CONFIRMING VERDICT OF THE COURT

In the matter of the people of Victoria v Rebecca Falkingham and Corri McKenzie

As you were indicted by a Grand Jury of your peers on the 10th August, 2022, you were therefore publicly summoned to appear in your private capacity, before a Jury of your peers. Rebecca Falkingham and Corri McKenzie, as living women, you failed to appear.

In relation to the Statement of Claim and the supporting evidence presented this day by the Prosecutor, the Jury, consisting of twelve reasonably minded men and women and having considered all the evidence presented at this hearing, issue the following orders:

The people find the Defendants, Rebecca Falkingham and Corri McKenzie guilty of abusing your positions in your private capacity as living women, of committing fraud against the men and women of Victoria, guilty of misprision of fraud, unconscionable conduct in public office, refusal to comply with Statutory Legislation, Criminal Coercion, misprision of the fact, knowing that Queen Elizabeth II was unlawfully removed and the creation of an unlawful Republic by the Act of 1986: bearing in mind ignorance of the law is no excuse, Masquerading as a Government Body in Victoria being aware that persons in Costume Masquerading as Sheriffs, which are in fact nothing more than Bailiffs, and failing to disclose this information to the people is in fact fraud; refusal to comply with United Nations Human Rights Charter 1948, refusal to comply with Common-Law, failing to accept the position of a living man or woman.
